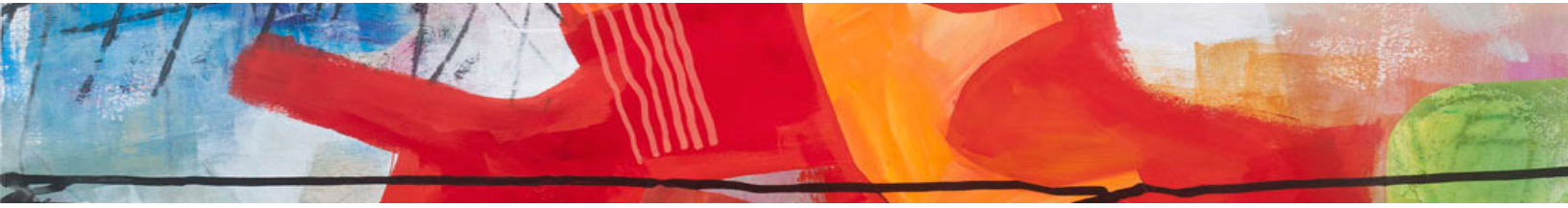

De-Stress with Art Supply List

- Acrylic paints: craft paints, acrylic gouache, student grade paint, and professional paints are all appropriate. I use all of the above. Be sure to include opaque paints such as Blick Matte Acrylics or Liquitex Acrylic Gouache.
- Paint markers: I use Posca Paint Markers - fine bullet tip or medium tip or a variety. Available from Blick and Amazon
- Fine white paint pens or gel pens
- Bamboo skewers
- Q-tips
- Wooden pencil with eraser (traditional pencil)
- Smooth surface paper such as Stonehenge Printmaking Paper (250 gsm) or Bristol (270 gsm): small pieces (5x7, or similar) for mandalas, larger - 9x12" - for transfer drawings.
- Canvases or panels for stripes: 10x10" or 12"x12" or 9"x12"
- Small panels, art boards, or canvas boards, 4"x4", at least 9
- Flat brushes, 1/2" and 3/4", several of each
- Matte medium, Utrecht brand, available from Blick, or whatever you have
- Variety of collage papers: lighter weight, not textured papers
- Akua Intaglio Ink - black or any dark color, one small jar
- Brayer: 2" - 3", soft rubber
- Cheap Drawing Paper, 9"x12"
- Glue Stick
- Paper towels
