

Supply List 100 Drawings on Cheap Paper with Jane Davies

- 1 Ream (500 sheets) of 80# drawing paper, 9"x12", or equivalent*
- Acrylic paints: your choice of colors plus black and white. A combination of craft paints or student-grade paints *and* professional quality paints works best.
- Drawing materials, such as graphite, Pitt pens, markers, paint markers, watercolor crayons, oil pastels.
- Acrylic matte medium to use for collage
- Acrylic glazing medium for diluting your paints
- Palette
- Brushes and other tools you ordinarily use (palette knife, brayer, etc.)
- Stamps and stencils (you can make these as needed if you don't have any)
- GelliArts gel printing plate, optional
- Rubbing alcohol

* This is the White Sulphite Drawing Paper from Blick Art Materials. If you don't have access to this specific paper, get something comparable. Heavier than copy paper, lighter than printmaking or watercolor paper. Cheap.
