



Working in Black and White Supply List

- Black acrylic paint: Golden Carbon Black is my favorite.
- White acrylic paint: Blick Matte Acrylics white (at least 1 8oz bottle)
- Brushes of your choice (see my Favorite Materials for the brushes I use)
- Pitt pens or Micron pens, fine and a few widths (black)
- Caran d'Ache neocolor II black and white crayons
- Paint markers such as Posca, in black and white and gray
- Paper for your substrate: I use Stonehenge Printmaking paper. Use a smooth surface, medium-weight paper similar to this. We'll be working small, so you can cut your paper to 8"x8" and/or 10"x10"
- Cheap Drawing Paper or even copy paper, or a sketchbook for doing line drawings
- Good painters tape such as Frog Tape, and/or peel-and-stick shelf paper
- Acrylic Matte Medium or Gel Medium or PVA glue for collage adhesive
- X-acto knife
- Contact paper (small roll)
